Please join us for a ride on county roads to visit local places of interest and end at the Crossroads restaurant in Attica. Allow 45 minutes for driving and stops along the way.

Start at Fort Ouiatenon.

Note: From US 231 and Indiana 25 head north to South River Road (next light) then, turn left, the park entrance will be a few miles on the left past the intersection with County Road 300 West.

From the fort turn left onto South River Road.



Granville Bridge, Granville

Continue west to County Road 700 West and turn left and cross over Granville Bridge.

Turn right on County Road 300 South. Road becomes Burton Road. You will go past the Peter Weaver house, one of the early settlers in Tippecanoe county.



Peter Weaver House, West Point

Turn right on Coolidge Road. Turn right on Turner Road.

Road becomes West County Line Road. Then, becomes County Road 1500 North.

Turn right at railroad track crossing onto East Flint Road.



Railroad viaduct with gravel road.

Road ends at County Road 1400 North, turn right.

Continue to Riverside. At the stop sign in Riverside turn left on County Road 500 East and head south.

You will pass by Bossaer Farms Bakery & Cafe, a location for past and future LIHAC breakfast tours.



Bossaer Farms Bakery & Cafe, Riverside

Turn right on County Road 1160 North, also known as Bethel Road.

In Attica road becomes Summit Street.

Turn left on Canada Street then, right on Main Street.

Turn left on Council Street. At the traffic light go straight across.

Road also becomes US 41.
