

Please join us for a ride on county roads to visit local places of interest and end at the Crossroads restaurant in Attica. Allow 45 minutes for driving and stops along the way.

Start at Fort Ouiatenon.

Note: From US 231 and Indiana 25 head north to South River Road (next light) then, turn left, the park entrance will be a few miles on the left past the intersection with County Road 300 West.



Wabash River, Fort Ouiatenon

From the fort turn left onto South River Road.



Downtown, Green Hill

Continue west to the town of Green Hill. Continue into town and turn left on Main Street which becomes County Road 650 North.

Turn left on County Road 1000 East and then, right on County Road 550 North then, left on County Road 825 East.



United Baptist Church, Independence

Enter the town of Independence, go straight at the stop sign and continue south on County Road 500 East. This is known as the “high road” route.

Cross over the Wabash River and enter the town of Riverside.



Downtown, Riverside

At the stop sign in Riverside continue south on County Road 500 East and head south.

You will pass by Bossaer Farms Bakery & Cafe, a location for past and future LIHAC breakfast tours.



Bossaer Farms Bakery & Cafe, Riverside

Turn right on County Road 1160 North, also known as Bethel Road.

In Attica road becomes Summit Street.



Church on Main Street, Attica

Turn left on Canada Street then, right on Main Street.

Further down Main Street is the Old Church and two houses restored by the John Cottrell Foundation. They were built in 1850 and restored in 1989.



Downtown, Attica

Turn left on Council Street. At the traffic light go straight across.

Road also becomes US 41.

Turn right at Crossroads restaurant.
