

Please join us for a ride on county roads to tour some small towns and have lunch in Cayuga (sounds like a Model A horn). Plan on two hours for driving and stops along the way.

Start at Fort Ouiatenon in West Lafayette.

Note: From US 231 and Indiana 25 head north to South River Road (next light) then, turn left. Drive for two and a half miles, the park entrance will be on the left, past the intersection with County Road 300 West.

From the fort turn left onto South River Road. Turn left onto County Road 1125 East just east of Green Hill.

Turn right onto County Road 500 North then, left onto County Road 1100 East.

Turn right onto Indy Road and go by Niches Park Weiler-Leopold Nature Preserve, entrance on your left.

Road becomes Independence Road.

Continue west through the town of Independence.

West of Independence and north on County Road 600 East is "Collage Rock", named for the area of Canada it is from. This is a boulder brought to the area by glaciers.

Turn left onto Indiana 55 and then it is a short distance to US 41. Turn left onto US 41.

Just after crossing the railroad bridge turn right onto South River Road and head to Williamsport.

The road becomes 3rd Street. Turn right onto Washington Street – jog left then, right – to stay on Washington Street.

Turn left onto Grant Street/County Road 050 East. Then, turn left onto County Road 100 East and head south over Shawnee Bridge.

After crossing the Wabash River you leave Warren County and enter Fountain County. Road becomes County Road 200 West or Williamsport Road.

The road becomes Pond Road and then back to County Road 170 West or Williamsport Road.

Turn right onto County Road 650 North and head west to Fountain.

The road becomes Main Street then bends to the left and becomes Washington Street/Portland Arch Road.

In Covington turn left onto Commercial Street, then right into McDonald's for a driving break. Leave McDonald's turning left onto Commercial Street. Turn left on 2nd Street. Continue south through Covington on 2nd Street, turn left onto Union Street, then, right onto 3rd Street.

Continue south, road becomes River Road. Turn right onto Towpath Road. Road becomes County Road 850 West/Silver Island Road.

Turn right into Cates-Clawson Reserve, there is parking for twelve cars.

Turn left onto County Road 700 South/Liberty Church Road. Then right turn onto Coffing Brothers Road. Coffing Brothers Orchard will

be on the left. They are one of the largest orchards in Indiana and have been in business for over 110 years.

In Silverwood merge onto State Road 234, go through Lodi and head west. Continue over the Wabash River and turn right onto Indiana 63. Then turn left onto County Road 600 North. At stop sign turn left, Covered Bridge Restaurant will be on your right.

After lunch option:

Visit to the Ernie Pyle museum in Dana (about a twenty minute drive from the Covered Bridge Restaurant to the museum). Head south on Main Street becomes Eugene Avenue, turn right onto County Road 400 North. Then left onto County Road 75 West. At State Road 71 turn right and continue into Dana. At the south end of town just before the railroad tracks turn right onto Briarwood Avenue, museum will be on your right.
