Please join us for a ride on county roads to visit local places of interest and end at Sportsman Inn in Monticello to have lunch. Allow forty-five minutes for driving and stops along the way.

Start at Tippecanoe Battlefield.

Note: The Tippecanoe Battlefield Park is located off Indiana 43 just south of the Interstate 65 interchange. Go south on Indiana 43 from Interstate 65 and as the road starts to narrow, turn left onto Burnetts Road then, left turn on North 9th Street. A couple miles to the park entrance.



Battlefield Memorial, Battle Ground

From the park turn left onto Railroad Street. At stop, turn right and go over tracks and bear to left onto Main Street.



Prophet's Rock, Battle Ground

North of the Battlefield Memorial is Prophet's Rock. This is where the Indian Prophet directed the Indians in the Battle of Tippecanoe.



Downtown, Battle Ground

Main Street turns into Pretty Prairie Road. Turn left onto Tyler Road.

Continue north, road becomes Springboro Road.

You will go past the entrance to Camp Tecumseh, YMCA camp.



Springboro Store, Springboro

Continue north, cross over Indiana 18. Turn right onto East Chalmers Road and head east a bit. Then left turn onto South Freeman Road.

South Freeman Road becomes 6th Street. At the round-about take the first exit and head east on Gordon Road.

At the traffic light bear right to go onto South Main Street/US 421/Indiana 39.

Just after crossing the bridge over the Tippecanoe River turn left onto Upper Lakeshore Drive, this is the entrance to the Sportsman Inn.


