Please join us for a ride on county roads to tour some small towns and breakfast in Riverside. Plan on thirty minutes for driving.

Start at Fort Ouiatenon in West Lafayette.

Note: From US 231 and Indiana 25 head north to South River Road (next light) then, turn left (west). Drive for two and a half miles, the park entrance will be on the left, past the intersection with County Road 300 West.



Wabash River, Fort Ouiatenon

From the fort turn left onto South River Road. Continue to Green Hill. Turn left onto County Road 1125 East and head south.



Downtown, Green Hill

Turn right onto County Road 500 North, it bends around and becomes 1100 East.



Weiler-Leopold Niches Land Trust, Independence

Road bends around again becoming Independence Road.

At Independence turn left onto Cicott Road / County Road 800 East (Warren county) / 500 East (Fountain county).



United Baptist Church, Independence

Cross over the Wabash River.

Go through Riverside and continue south on County Road 500 East.



Old Barn, Riverside

About one mile south of Riverside turn right into Bossaer Farms. We will have breakfast at the Bakery & Cafe.

Bossaer Farms Bakery & Cafe is open Wednesday through Saturday, 7:30 AM to 2 PM.



Bossaer Farms Bakery & Cafe, Riverside

When leaving you can continue south on County Road 500 East to Indiana State Route 28, just a couple miles south.

Or you can go back the way we came but turn right at the stop sign just past the railroad tracks. This is a very nice road that will take you to Indiana State Route 25 in West Point.

For a side trip, go back to Independence and turn left at the four way stop and drive west through town.



College Rock, Independence

Turn right on County Road 600 East, about one mile south on the right side of the road is College Rock. After talking with some of the professors at Purdue I believe it is miss-named and should be called Collage Rock as it probably came from the Canadian Collage which includes the Canadian Shield, a source of many rocks brought down by the ice age glaciers.
