

Please join us for a ride on county roads to visit local places of interest and end at the waterfall in Williamsport. Allow 2 1/2 hours for driving and stops along the way.

**Start at Fort Ouiatenon.**

**Note:** From US 231 and Indiana 25 head north to South River Road (next light) then, turn left, the park entrance will be a few miles on the left past the intersection with County Road 300 West.



**Wabash River, Fort Ouiatenon**

From the fort turn left onto South River Road.



**Granville Bridge, Granville**

Continue west to County Road 700 West and turn left and cross over Granville Bridge.

Turn right on County Road 300 South. Road becomes Burton Road. You will go past the Peter Weaver house, one of the early settlers in Tippecanoe county.



**Peter Weaver House, West Point**

Turn right on Coolidge Road. Turn right on Turner Road.

Road becomes West County Line Road. Then, becomes County Road 1500 North.



**Old Stuff antique store, West Point**

Turn right at railroad track crossing onto East Flint Road.



**Railroad viaduct with gravel road.**

Road ends at County Road 1400 North, turn right.

Continue through Riverside. In Attica road becomes North Perry Street. At West Mill Street turn right.



**Devon Theater, Attica**

Turn left on South Market Street.

Turn right on West Jackson Street (Indiana 28, US 41) and go over the Wabash River on the Paul Dresser (singer, song writer, famous for “On the Banks of the Wabash, Far Away”) bridge.



**M4A1 Sherman Tank, VFW, Attica**

Turn left onto South River Road. In Williamsport road becomes South 3<sup>rd</sup> Street. Turn right onto East Monroe Street.

As you cross over a short bridge, with Fall Street on your left, turn right onto a drive that goes behind buildings. Either park next to the street in the empty lot or continue behind the buildings to the falls overlook.

**Note:** Williamsport Falls is the highest waterfall in Indiana at 93 feet.



**Williamsport Falls, Williamsport**

Leave the falls by turning right onto North Monroe Street and cross the railroad tracks. At the Warren County Courthouse turn right onto East 2<sup>nd</sup> Street (Indiana 28).



**Warren County Courthouse, Williamsport**

Continue on Indiana 28 to US 41 and turn left. In a few feet turn right onto South Moore’s Hill Road (County Road 125 East).

At wye intersection bear right onto County Road East 150 North. To the right you may see some of the remains of the Mudlavia hotel and spa.



**Mudlavia hotel & spa, Kramer**

Continue through Kramer. Turn left onto County Road North 225 East then, right onto County Road East 250 North.

Turn left onto Indiana 55 then, right onto County Road East 600 North.  
At Chatterton turn right onto North Independence Pine Village Road. Then left onto County Road East 550 North. Left turn onto County Road North 1000 East then, right onto County Road East 650 North. Go through the town of Green Hill.



**Green Hill**

In Green Hill road becomes Main Street. Turn right onto Pine Street, road becomes County Road East 675 North.

After a zigzag road becomes County Road 700 North, then Base Line Road/Division Road.

Just after crossing the bridge over Jordan Creek turn left onto Division Road. Turn left

onto County Road 350 West then, left onto County Road 400 West. Cross Indiana 26 and then, turn right onto County Road 250 North.

Continue into West Lafayette, turn right on to Soldiers Home Road and cross over Sagamore Parkway. Turn right on to Chippewa Street and turn right onto Navajo Street then, right onto Nighthawk Drive and left to Dog n Suds.
